



## 2023 Louisa-Muscatine High School Scholarships Community Foundation of Greater Muscatine

- 1. Bishop Educational Trust Scholarship:** A select number of scholarships awarded to students who have the desire to attend college in the state of Iowa but need financial assistance in pursuing their educational goals. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and are required to submit their FAFSA SAR report or their parents most recent income tax return. Applicants must attend a college or university in the state of Iowa with a preference given to students attending Muscatine Community College.
- 2. Francis Edward and Patricia Anne Carroll Scholarship:** A \$1,500 scholarship award given in honor of Francis and Pat Carroll. The Carrolls raised eleven children, all of whom graduated from Louisa-Muscatine High School and went to college. The scholarship will recognize a Louisa-Muscatine High School graduating senior attending post-secondary education in the state of Iowa with preference given to students attending Muscatine Community College. Further preference will be given to students pursuing a career in education or teaching.
- 3. John A. Wojtecki, Ph.D. Endowed Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship award established by John A. Wojtecki, Ph.D. for a graduating senior from Louisa-Muscatine High School, Muscatine High School, or Wilton Junior/Senior High School pursuing post-secondary education in the state of Iowa to study music, healthcare, or trades. Recipients will have no other local scholarship awards with a value over \$2,000. Preference will be given to students who participated in a high school music program for two of four years.
- 4. Michel's Family Educational Trust Scholarship:** A select number of scholarships awarded to students who have the desire and ability to attend college but may need financial support. Recipient must attend Muscatine Community College or Drake University. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and are required to submit their FAFSA SAR report or their parents most recent income tax return.
- 5. Muscatine County Soil and Water Conservation District's Ralph L. Kirchner Memorial Scholarship:** Up to five \$1,000 scholarship awards established by the Muscatine County Soil and Water Conservation District in memory of former West Liberty farmer Ralph L. Kirchner, who served on the Muscatine County Soil and Water Conservation District Board of Directors for 25 years. The scholarship will recognize graduating seniors pursuing a career in conservation or agriculture. Preference will be given to full-time students in these fields of study. To be eligible, applicants must be a resident of Muscatine County, have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, and demonstrate unmet financial need.

- 6. Muscatine Power and Water (MPW) Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship award for a graduating senior of Louisa-Muscatine High School who is interested in pursuing a degree in a field applicable to a future career/employment at MPW. Degrees in fields such as, but not limited to business, accounting, engineering, energy efficiency, environmental science, IT, or skilled trades. Special consideration will be given to students who plan to return to Muscatine in their profession. Student must be a child of an MPW customer and plan to attend an accredited college/institution (technical, 2-year or 4-year). Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or greater.
- 7. Temp Associates and RJK, Inc. Louisa-Muscatine High School Scholarship:** A \$4,000 scholarship award established by Bob and JoAnn Jensen for a Louisa-Muscatine High School graduating senior with a desire to further their education and pursue post-secondary education full-time at any accredited two- or four-year college or university in the state of Iowa. To be eligible, applicants must demonstrate: a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher, good character, citizenship, and a desire to further their education. The scholarship is renewable an additional three years, for a total term of four consecutive years, provided the student is enrolled full-time and maintains a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA in college. In total, the value of the scholarship award over four years of post-secondary education is \$16,000. Preference will be given to applicants with a relative who is a current or former Temp Associates and RJK, Inc. employee.
- 8. Toyota of Muscatine Scholarship:** Up to two \$2,000 scholarship awards established by Toyota of Muscatine for graduating seniors who are residents of Muscatine County intending to pursue a career in an automotive program. Applicants must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA or higher and demonstrate unmet financial need. Preference will be given to award one female and one male who are enrolling in an automotive program such as but not limited to automotive technology and automotive collision repair. The scholarship is renewable for the second year of enrollment within the same post-secondary educational program.
- 9. Wulf Family Scholarship Endowment in Memory of Helen P. Wulf:** A \$500 scholarship award for a graduating senior of Muscatine High School or Louisa-Muscatine High School pursuing post-secondary education in a health-related field of study which upon completion will lead to a professional certificate or college degree. Recipient will have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Preference will be given to students who can demonstrate financial need in obtaining their post-secondary education. Additional preference will be given to students who are children, grandchildren, or great-grandchildren of members of the Muscatine Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW). This scholarship is given as a memorial to Helen P. Wulf, who served as a Registered Nurse for over 48 years in Muscatine and was honored for 62 years of dedicated service as an active member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary.
