



## 2022 Muscatine High School Scholarships Community Foundation of Greater Muscatine

1. **AARON BOYSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$2,500 scholarship award, available through the Iowa Foundation for Agricultural Advancement (IFAA) and Kent Nutrition Group, for Muscatine and Louisa County graduating seniors entering the field of agriculture in memorial of Aaron Boysen, a dedicated Kent feeds employee, agriculture enthusiast and family man.
2. **BERNADETTE M. ROHLING SCHOLARSHIP:** Four \$1,000 scholarship awards in memory of Bernadette M. Rohling to Muscatine High School graduating seniors pursuing a teaching career.
3. **BILL STAMLER SCHOLARSHIP:** A scholarship award given in memory of Bill Stamler for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at Muscatine Community College.
4. **BISHOP EDUCATIONAL TRUST SCHOLARSHIP:** The Bishop Educational Trust awards a select number of scholarships annually to students who have the desire to attend college but need financial assistance in pursuing their educational goals. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and are required to submit their FAFSA SAR report or their parents most recent income tax return. Applicants must attend a college or university in the state of Iowa with preference given to students attending Muscatine Community College.
5. **BRANT W. BRUHN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship award for Muscatine High School graduating seniors, one male and one female, in memory of Brant W. Bruhn. Brant coached high school football for more than 20 years, including at Muscatine High School, and sports were a life-long love for Brant. Preference will be given to students who have volunteer experience as a sporting event official, referee, or a coach.

6. **BRUCE C. HEEZEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Six \$1,000 renewable scholarships awarded in memory of Bruce C. Heezen to Muscatine High School graduating seniors attending any accredited post-secondary educational institution of higher learning.
7. **CHARLES AND NORMA LEWIS SCHOLARSHIP:** Four \$5,000 renewable scholarship awards for graduating seniors from Muscatine High School, two male and two female, pursuing post-secondary education in a field of study related to agriculture. Students must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher and be attending an accredited college or university in the state of Iowa.
8. **CLARE SCHERRER SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT:** A \$5,000 renewable scholarship to assist demonstrated high achieving students who are thriving to attend a world class university and have the skill and ambition to succeed in their chosen field of study but would otherwise have difficulty affording the cost of that program.
9. **CLASS OF 1953 SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award established by the graduating class of 1953 for a Muscatine High School graduating senior that attended MHS all four academic years of high school.
10. **CLASS OF 1956 SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award established by the graduating class of 1956 for one graduating senior of Muscatine High School showing strong motivation and work ethic.
11. **CLASS OF 1974 SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award established by the graduating class of 1974 for a Muscatine High School graduating senior that attended MHS all four academic years of high school.
12. **CLASS OF 1984 SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$200 scholarship award established by the graduating class of 1984 for a Muscatine High School graduating senior in the top 1/3 of their class academically who participated in at least two extracurricular activities and/or sports during their senior year.
13. **COLORADO P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$400 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who completed fifth grade at Colorado Elementary School.

14. **DIANNE DALBEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$700 scholarship awards given in memory of Dianne R. Dalbey to Muscatine High School graduating seniors pursuing a paramedic certification or any health-related career with preference given to nursing.
15. **DIWAN-NADKARNI CHARITABLE SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college or university to study a field of interest in science.
16. **DONALD AND DOROTHY PLATT SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award established by Don and Dorothy Platt, in honor of Dorothy a retired Muscatine elementary teacher, for Muscatine High School graduating seniors planning to pursue a career in elementary education.
17. **DR. JOHN A. WATSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$3,000 scholarship award given in memory of Dr. Watson, former administrator of Muscatine Community Schools, for a Muscatine High School graduating senior showing strong motivation and work ethic. Priority consideration is given to students interested in pursuing a career as a teacher.
18. **DR. RUSSELL N. WARD SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$200 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior given in honor of Dr. Ward, former superintendent of Muscatine Community Schools.
19. **ED WARE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award given in memory of Ed Ware, former Muscatine Community School District teacher. The scholarship will recognize a Muscatine High School graduating senior who demonstrates strong leadership abilities, good character, and participation in school activities.
20. **ELAINE MAY YMCA SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award given in memory of Elaine May; a dedicated wife, mother, community member and volunteer. Elaine's life was the embodiment of the YMCA's motto: building strong kids, strong families, and strong communities. The scholarship will recognize a Muscatine High School graduating senior who participated in either swimming, track, or golf.
21. **ELVIRA TREVARTHEN SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,300 scholarship award given in memory of Elvira Trevarthen for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a career in nursing.

22. **FLICKINGER LEARNING CENTER ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior who attended the Flickinger Learning Center educational after-school program in 5th grade and is pursuing post-secondary education at an Iowa educational institution.
23. **FOSHOLT SCHOLARSHIP IN ENGINEERING OR ARCHITECTURE:** A \$2,000 renewable scholarship award established by Sanford K. Fosholt for a graduate of Muscatine High School beginning a college education in engineering or architecture at Muscatine Community College, Iowa State University, or the University of Iowa.
24. **FRED G. MESSENGER SCHOLARSHIP:** A scholarship award given in memory of Mr. Messenger, who was principal of Muscatine High School for 36 years. The scholarship will recognize a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at Muscatine Community College.
25. **GARFIELD/FRANKLIN P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP:** Three \$500 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who completed fourth and fifth grades at Franklin Elementary School.
26. **GERALD GARVIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award given in memory of Gerald Garvin to a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at Muscatine Community College.
27. **GERTRUDE J. SYWASSINK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Three \$3,000 renewable scholarships available for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, demonstrate financial need, and plan to attend a two- or four-year accredited college or university working towards an education degree. Preference will be given to those planning to attend college within the state of Iowa.
28. **GRACIELA (COCA) V. PAGE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award for a female Latina graduating from Muscatine High School with preference given to former English Language Students (ESL/EL).
29. **GRANT P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP:** Three \$300 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who attended Grant Elementary School for three years.

30. **HALL OF HONOR SCHOLARSHIP:** Up to five \$1,000 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating senior who is a good citizen to their school and community.
31. **HAROLD & CORRINE MARX SCHOLARSHIP:** Up to five \$1,000 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating senior showing strong motivation and dedicated work ethic. Preference given to applicants attending a technical or trade school.
32. **HAROLD OGILVIE, SR., AND E. HERBERT CARLSON SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award sponsored by the Muscatine Kiwanis Club in memory of Harold Ogilvie, Sr. and E. Herbert Carlson for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.
33. **HARRY J. AND NELLIE B. GRIFFITH MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP:** A scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at Muscatine Community College. This scholarship is funded from the estate of Mr. Harry J. Griffith, a former Wilton businessman.
34. **HENRY MILLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$2,000 scholarship award sponsored by the Muscatine Kiwanis Club in memory of Henry Miller for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.
35. **H.J. HEINZ SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior who is a good citizen and has been active in extra-curricular activities. Priority consideration is given to children or grandchildren of an active Heinz employee.
36. **ILLEEN M. ROHLING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Three \$1,000 of scholarship awards given in memory of Illeen M. Rohling for Muscatine High School graduating seniors planning to pursue a medical career. Primary consideration will be given to those pursuing a BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing).
37. **JEAN LETTENBERGER SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award for the recipient of the Hahn Trophy for Girls' Swimming, given in memory of Jean Lettenberger, a 1976 MHS graduate and Hahn Trophy recipient.

38. **JEANETTE PHILLIPS CROSSROADS SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$250 scholarship award established by Jeanette Phillips, a retired Muscatine elementary teacher, for a Muscatine High School graduating senior who intends to pursue a career working with people in the mentally or physically challenged community.
39. **JEFF TANK MHS GIRLS BASKETBALL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards given in memory of Jeffrey Tank, coach of the Muscatine High School Girls Basketball team for 28 years. This scholarship will recognize graduating seniors who participated one year or more in Muscatine High School Girls Basketball and exemplify the qualities Coach Tank encouraged in a player; a great teammate who displayed a positive attitude.
40. **JEFFERSON ELEMENTARY CULTURE FAIR SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards for graduating Muscatine High School seniors who attended Jefferson Elementary School.
41. **JEFFERSON P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who completed fourth and fifth grades at Jefferson Elementary School.
42. **JILL MORAVEC MEMORIAL MUSCATINE BAND BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award given in memory of Jill Moravec for a Muscatine High School graduating senior who participated in Band during their Junior and Senior years of high school and is planning to attend an accredited college, university or community college in the state of Iowa as a full-time student and continue participation in band music performance as a part of the higher education program. A music major is not required.
43. **JIM AND ARLENE KAEDING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$600 scholarship award given in memory of Jim and Arlene Kaeding for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a career in education, athletic training, or exercise science. Arlene taught elementary education for the Muscatine Community School District and Jim was a former math teacher, basketball coach, and assistant principal for the Muscatine Community School District.

44. **JOHN A. WOJTECKI, PH.D. ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award established by John A. Wojtecki, Ph.D. for a graduating senior from Louisa-Muscatine High School, Muscatine High School or Wilton Junior/Senior High School pursuing post-secondary education in the state of Iowa to study music, healthcare, or trades. Preference will be given to students who participated in a high school music program for two of four years.
45. **JULIA WOJTECKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award given in memory of Julia Wojtecki, a Muscatine High School student who died suddenly in the spring of 1999. The Wojtecki family wishes to financially assist a Muscatine High School graduating senior who reflects the positive attributes Julia possessed. Preference will be given to students who participated in a high school instrumental music program all four years.
46. **KATHY J. BROOKER-DECKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award given in memory of Kathy J. Brooker-Decker for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a career in education who demonstrates good character, leadership, and citizenship through volunteer experience during their high school career. Preference will be given to those who have excelled in Advanced Placement (AP) coursework in English, Literature, Composition and/or Language.
47. **KEVIN K. BIRKHOFFER STEM SCHOLARSHIP FUND:** A \$5,000 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited public University in the state of Iowa with a plan to obtain a bachelor's degree in any field related to science, technology, engineering, or mathematics.
48. **KRIEGER FOOD & NUTRITION SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award provided by the Marvin and Betty Krieger Memorial Scholarship Fund for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a career in food and nutrition.
49. **KRIEGER TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award provided by the Marvin and Betty Krieger Memorial Scholarship Fund for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a technical career such as, but not limited to; automotive technology, electrical and plumbing.

50. **LARRY FULLINGTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,500 scholarship award given in memory of Larry Fullington for a Muscatine High School graduating senior planning to attend Muscatine Community College. Larry was a member of the U.S. Coast Guard and a retired janitor from the Muscatine Community School District. He was a proud supporter of the student athletes at Muscatine High School and enjoyed attending their events.
51. **MADISON P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards available for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who completed two years of grades 3rd, 4th, or 5th at Madison Elementary School.
52. **MANUEL T. CADENA SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award provided by the Manuel Cadena Educational Foundation for a Muscatine High School graduating senior planning to major in engineering, art, or music.
53. **MARIE C. RUTHENBERG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award given in memory of Marie C. Ruthenberg for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a teaching career. The scholarship was established in 1986 to encourage a MHS senior to pursue a teaching career in the spirit of Mrs. Ruthenberg, her dedication to the profession is evidenced by her service as an educator for more than 50 years in the Muscatine Community School District.
54. **MATTHEW B. SELIGMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award given in memory of Matthew Seligman. Matt understood adversity, as he was diagnosed with type 1 diabetes (T1D) at six years old; he respected the disease, but he never let it control his life. Matt was proud to be a Muskie and his motto was "Never settle for less than your best"! While in his junior year at MHS (2004), Matt passed away due to complications of living with T1D. His legacy continues to live on by being a small part of someone else's dream.
55. **MAURICE & DONNA REED SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a degree in science.
56. **MAX A. COLLINS, SR. SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$2,000 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a major in music or who will continue music participation in their future communities. This scholarship award was established by the Muscatine Elks' Chanters to honor their long time Director, Max A. Collins, Sr.



57. **MCKINLEY P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP:** Four \$250 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who completed 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grades at McKinley Elementary School.
58. **MENTE FELLOWSHIP OF CHRISTIAN ATHLETES SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award established by Glen and Mary Jo Mente, formerly of Muscatine, to foster participation in the Muscatine Fellowship of Christian Athletes. The recipient will be a Muscatine High School graduating senior and member of FCA.
59. **MICAELA L. BRUNSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Three \$1,000 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors pursuing post-secondary education to study a helping profession such as, but not limited to; pre-medical, nursing, teaching, or counseling. The Micaela L. Brunson Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by Brian and Alma Brunson in memory of their beloved daughter. Micaela was a special friend to many and lived her days under the motto *“Be somebody that makes everyone else feel like somebody.”*
60. **MICHEL’S EDUCATIONAL TRUST SCHOLARSHIP:** A select number of scholarships awarded to students who have the desire and ability to attend college but may need financial support. Recipient must attend Muscatine Community College or Drake University.
61. **MULBERRY P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors who completed 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grades at Mulberry Elementary School.
62. **MUSCATINE BAND BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior who participated in band during their Junior and Senior years of High School. The recipient must plan to attend a post-secondary school as a full-time student and continue participation in instrumental music performance. A music major is not required.
63. **MUSCATINE COMMUNITY SCHOOL FOUNDATION COMMUNITY SERVICE/VOLUNTEER SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards to recognize Muscatine High School graduating seniors who serve the community through various forms of volunteer service. A minimum of 100 hours of documented volunteer community service is required.

64. **MUSCATINE COMMUNITY SCHOOL FOUNDATION GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards to recognize Muscatine High School graduating seniors who have gone beyond that which is required both in numbers and types of courses but does not rank at the top of their class and has not previously received other scholarship recognition. Preference will be given to students who have demonstrated the willingness to take challenging coursework throughout their high school career.
65. **MUSCATINE COUNTY SHERIFF'S PATROL SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards to be used at any accredited college or junior college. Recipient will be a Muscatine County graduating senior intending to pursue a career in law enforcement, criminal justice or a related field and will be selected based on academic achievement and participation in extracurricular activities.
66. **MUSCATINE COUNTY SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT'S RALPH L. KIRCHNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Up to five \$1,000 scholarship awards established by the Muscatine County Soil and Water Conservation District in memory of former West Liberty farmer Ralph L. Kirchner, who served on the Muscatine County Soil and Water Conservation District Board of Directors for 25 years. The scholarship will recognize graduating seniors pursuing a career in conservation or agriculture. Preference will be given to full-time students in these fields of study.
67. **MUSCATINE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION (MEA):** Three \$500 scholarship awards provided by the MEA for Muscatine High School graduating seniors. Each recipient must have a parent who is a current member of the MEA.
68. **MUSCATINE POWER & WATER SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$500 scholarship awards for graduating Muscatine High School seniors pursuing a degree in a field applicable to a future career at MP&W. Degrees in fields such as, but not limited to; business, accounting, engineering, energy efficiency, environmental science, IT, skilled trades, etc. qualify. Special consideration will be given to students who plan to return to Muscatine in their profession.
69. **MUSCATINE SOCCER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$300 scholarship awards provided by the Muscatine Soccer Club, one for a male soccer player and one for a female soccer player, who participated in Muscatine Soccer Club activities as well as Muscatine High School Soccer. Preference will be given to students involved the

most years in MSC and MHS Soccer.

70. **MUSCATINE YOUTH GIRLS BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP:** Up to four \$700 scholarships for graduating seniors who participated in MHS Girls Basketball all four years of high school and participated in Muscatine Youth Girls Basketball a minimum of three years.
71. **NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORT SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,500 scholarship award for a graduating senior from Muscatine High School pursuing a career in the medical field. Non-Emergency Transport was established by Dana and Kenny LaRue, who realized there was a need within the Muscatine community for safe, reliable transport for people in wheelchairs or people in need of assistance. We proudly service the local Muscatine community, including Iowa City, Davenport, and the Quad Cities region.
72. **PATRICIA COSS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior attending any accredited two- or four-year college or university. Special consideration will be given to students who attended Madison Elementary School or students who have demonstrated the ability to overcome adversity.
73. **PAUL C. ROHLING SCHOLARSHIP:** Three \$1,000 scholarship awards given in honor of Paul C. Rohling, for Muscatine High School graduating seniors enrolling in post-secondary education to pursue a career in agriculture. Secondary consideration will be given to those pursuing a career as a physical education teacher or coach.
74. **PILOT CLUB OF MUSCATINE AND MUSCATINE MASONIC IOWA LODGE #2:** A \$500 scholarship award for a student who plans on attending Muscatine Community College.
75. **ROACH BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$1,000 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing a business degree. To qualify, the student must have taken a business course at MHS or through dual enrollment at MCC. The scholarship was established by Robert L. Roach in honor of his son, William L. Roach II, to recognize a student at Muscatine High School who has outstanding achievement in business administration.

76. **ROACH OPEN SCHOLARSHIPS:** Two \$1,000 scholarship awards for Muscatine High School graduating seniors of high moral character who possess the qualities of citizenship, service, and leadership. The scholarship was established by Robert L. Roach in memory of his son, William L. Roach II, who died in 1937 of complications from polio. Bill, as he was known to friends, was involved in various activities at MHS such as track, football, Auroran staff and student council.
77. **ROBERT NIETZEL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award established by the Nietzel family as a memorial to Robert Nietzel, who was an active supporter of Muscatine High School activities. To qualify, applicants must be a Muscatine High School graduating senior and demonstrate: financial need, good character, citizenship, and a desire to further their education.
78. **ROBERT P. HERWIG SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award for a Muscatine High School graduating senior who plans to attend Muscatine Community College and pursue a career in education. The scholarship is given in honor of Robert P. Herwig who served as a teacher, coach, and administrator in the Muscatine Community School District for over 35 years.
79. **ROBERT W. AND DOROTHY M. TOBORG SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$2,500 scholarship awards given in memory of Robert W. and Dorothy M. Toborg for Muscatine High School graduating seniors involved in high school, church, or other community activities.
80. **ROBERTA SUE THACKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship has been established in memory of Roberta Thacker by her family. The award will be for a graduating MHS student athlete who has at least a 2.5 GPA and is planning to major in education with the intent of pursuing a teaching career. This scholarship honors Roberta Sue Thacker, a 1980 MHS honor graduate who excelled in many sports. She competed at the state level in softball and track and won many athletic and academic honors. She graduated from UNI with a degree in Special Education and taught for 10 years in Bedford, Iowa and Wilton, Iowa.
81. **RONALD C. ROHLING SCHOLARSHIP:** A select number of scholarship awards given in honor of Ronald C. Rohling for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at the University of Iowa.

82. **RONALD D. AND MARILYN A. STURMS ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$500 scholarship award for a graduating senior from Muscatine High School planning to attend an Iowa accredited post-secondary educational institution studying in a Business-related major or Family and Consumer Sciences major. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and demonstrate some unmet financial need. Preference will be given to students enrolling in an accredited community college.
83. **RONALD ROHLING SCHOLARSHIP:** A scholarship award given in honor of Ronald Rohling for a Muscatine High School graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education at the University of Iowa with a preference for students in the College of Liberal Arts.
84. **ROTARY CLUB OF MUSCATINE SCHOLARSHIP:** Rotary Club of Muscatine awards five \$1,000 scholarships to students attending Muscatine Community College and a select number of scholarships to students attending other Iowa colleges or universities.
85. **RUTH SCHOLARSHIP:** A \$200 scholarship award established by an anonymous donor, who placed a high value on education and believed in the quality of education provided by the Muscatine Community School District. The scholarship will recognize a Muscatine High School graduating senior who has shown academic achievement and educational excellence.

SCHOLARSHIP:** Four \$4,000 renewable scholarship awards established by Bob and JoAnn Jensen for Muscatine High School graduating seniors with a desire to further their education and pursue post-secondary education in the state of Iowa.
